Welcome guest preacher-Pastor Vaugelas Pierre

Pastor Pierre, born and raised in Cap Haitien, northern Haiti, was orphaned as a teenager. He left the impoverished island, but God called him to return in 1975 to educate children and preach in La Croix, near Gonaives. Since then, the ministry has grown from 200 students to over 3,500 attending seven school campuses with PreK-13, including a vocational program. Pastor Pierre and his wife Ermithe oversee the schools, two medical clinics, pastors and congregations at seven churches, and they regularly distribute food to La Croix and beyond.




